CHOIR: Choir rehearsal begins on **Wednesday, November 3rd**, 5:30PM - 6:15PM. All are welcome!

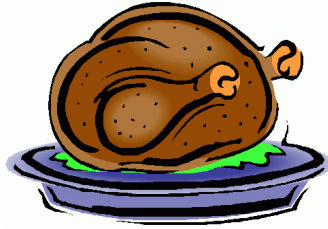
